

I. Content of the Manuscript

- A. The manuscript in general is organized in the following order:
 - 1. Title Page
 - 2. Abstract
 - 3. Text (Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion and Recommendation)
 - 4. End Notes
 - 5. Reference List
- B. The title page of the paper should contain
 - 1. Full title of the paper
 - 2. Full name/s of the author/s
 - 3. Name/s and address/es of institutions where the work was done.
 - 4. Name, address, telephone/fax numbers of the author to whom all correspondence and proofs should be sent
 - 5. A running title of not more than 40 characters including spaces, and no more than six key words.
- C. Abstract should not more than 200 words. Keywords must also be provided and not more than eight words in alphabetical order.
- D. Spelling should conform with the Webster International Dictionary.
- E. Units of measurement, symbols and abbreviations must be written in metric units.
- F. Drawing, graphs, tables and illustrations should be presented as follows:
 - 1. Computer-generated, laser-printed or conforming to specific printing standards.
 - 2. Photographs should be bromide prints of good contrast.
 - 3. Illustrations should be labeled with figure number and authors' name written in soft pencil at the back.
 - 4. Scales maybe indicated in the figure legends.
 - 5. Line diagrams can be computer-generated but must be produced by laser printer.
 - 6. Unpublished reports, ongoing researches, manuscripts in progress should not be cited; otherwise they should be referred to as unpublished in the text.
- II. Format of the Manuscript
 - A. A paper must not exceed 20 pages (typeset, double-spaced) on ones side of short bond paper (8.5" x 11") including illustrations, notes and references.
 - B. All pages should be numbered in Arabic numerals.
 - C. Tables, diagrams, graphs, etc. should be properly numbered, labeled and included in the numbering of pages of the text.
 - D. The American Psychological Association (APA) style of notation and reference listing, with minor modifications will be used for all articles.
 - E. Only works cited in the paper should be listed as references and arranged in alphabetical order.
